



Privacy Policy

LawWare will control the information which you provide on registration and subsequently during any visit to this website at www.lawware.co.uk ("the Website").

LawWare may use your information for the following purposes: to provide you with information about updates and changes to this site; to help improve the content of the Website and the service LawWare offers to users of the Website ("Users"); to provide Users with information regarding updates or additional services available through the Website; to carry out our own demographic research analysis. LawWare will not sell, rent or transfer your information except in an aggregated form to any third party. 'Cookies' are small data files sent by a web server to a web browser in order to enable the server to collect information back from the browser.



LawWare uses 'cookies' to track Users' sessions at the Website to identify returning Users and to enable LawWare to customise the home page of the site according to Users' previous browsing habits at the site. You can delete cookies from your hard drive at any time.
